Finally, after many months of waiting, Hermitage Road will soon be a School Street! This is an exciting time for us, as our children will join the 11,500 children at 30 other schools, nurseries and colleges in Haringey who are now benefitting from cleaner air around their school.

When a School Street is in operation, the road temporarily becomes a Pedestrian and Cycle Zone, at school drop-off and pick-up times. NO VEHICLES will be able to use Hermitage Road from 8.15am – 9am and 2.45pm – 3.45pm.

Vehicles that enter the School Street without an exemption, during operational hours, will be identified by camera and may be issued a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) by Haringey Local Authority.

Once we are given a date, we will let you know when the School Street comes into force.




The children have been enjoying their new music unit of drumming this week!

During the season of Lent, we are saying our prayer reflections every day.


Reception have been reading the book Oliver's Vegetables as part of their literacy unit
