Dear parents and carers,

Schools have received notification from the Local Authority that major repair works along West Green Road will begin next week. Cadent Gas is starting a project to improve the reliability of its network across north London, with closures to West Green Road for about 10 weeks from Tuesday 7th May to Sunday 21 July 2024. **Please take time to plan your journey to school, so your child is able to arrive on time.**

Cadent Gas is closing the following roads:

- West Green Road between Westerfield Road and Portland Road and High Road from 7th May to 21st July;
- Westerfield Road, at the junction with West Green Road, with access only via Seven Sisters Road

Traffic travelling between Turnpike Lane and Seven Sisters will be diverted to use Green Lanes and Seven Sisters Road.

Bus diversions will be in place, as well as temporary changes to certain parts of the Bruce Grove West Green and St Ann's Low Traffic Neighbourhood (LTN) trials.
